

Industry's Workforce Challenge

WHO WILL BUILD YOUR PROJECTS?

- 75 million baby boomers approaching retirement age
- For the next 19 years, 10,000 baby boomers will reach age 65 each day
- 20% of the construction workforce will retire in the next 2 4 years
- 2018: More than ½ of the U.S. population was over 50
- FMI predicts will need at least 1,500,000 new workers and the Construction Labor Research Council (CLRC) says 2,000,000 needed annually for the next decade
- Our workforce shortages are driven demographics. We have a third less 18-30 year old than we did 30 years ago and an increasing population of 65 year old.
