ABOUT THE AWARDS PROGRAM

The American Concrete Institute is a global organization dedicated to the advancement of concrete technologu through research and education. The Rocky Mountain Chapter ACI brings this same education and advancement of concrete technology to Colorado. As part of that mission the Rocky Mountain Chapter ACI hosts the Excellence in Concrete Awards. In its 51st year, the program recognizes excellence in architectural and structural design as well as the unique, innovative, and sustainable uses of concrete in Colorado construction projects.

PROJECT RECOGNITION

The Rocky Mountain Chapter of ACI (RMACI) will recog-nize your professional accomplishments at the 2020 Excellence in Concrete Awards Banquet. The banquet will be held at the Lakewood Country Club in April, 2020. The three designated project team members for each project category will be presented with an attractive Excellence in Concrete Award at the banquet. All projects submitted will receive recognition at the awards banquet; however, winners are held confidential until the night of the event. The RMACI will also send press releases to local and national industry related publications including the American Concrete Institute's Concrete International magazine.

The RMACI Board of Directors will select local projec winners, the number at its discretion, for nomination to the ACI National 2020 Excellence in Concrete Construction Awards. The projects will compete in an international competition with awardees being recog-nized at the 2020 ACI Fall Concrete Convention and Exposition in Raleigh, North Carolina,

Nominations will be accepted for projects completed in the state of Colorado from January 1, 2017, through December 31, 2019.

- ✓ Nominations are accepted from any person/firm involved in the project
- Project can utilize any type of Portland cement concrete -shatcrete, self consolidating, roller compacted, pervious.
- Project construction can be standard forming, tilt-up. pre-cast, shotcrete, or cast-in-place
- ✓ Projects constructed in phases are eligible for competition at the completion of each phase as well. as at the time of completion of the overall project.

PROJECT CATEGORIES

Submittats are invited in the following categories:

- Commercial/Industrial Buildings privately funded projects such as office buildings, hospitals, sports facilities, manufacturing or warehouse facilities, parking structures
- Residential mutti-family or single family
- Civic Structures publicly funded projects such as schools, military facilities, community water parks
- Infrastructure bridges, tunnels, roads, water and
- Flatwork/Paving parking lots, overlays, runways Decorative Concrete - floors, artwork, specialty
- architectural features Restoration/Repair - repair of existing concrete in

WHAT TO SUBMIT

- 1. Complete the Excellence in Concrete Awards Entru Form. Submitter needs to obtain the project ow permission to submit the project and check the Owner's Consent box on the nomination form.
- 2. Please ensure the proper spelling of all company names on the nomination form as this information will be used for the engraving on the awards if the judging panel selects your project for an award.



- 3. Prepare the submission documents. Project Facts & Project Description are used by the judging panel to evaluate your project. It is highly recommende that you collaborate with other members of the project team to provide the most comprehensive project description. To view sample project descriptions, please visit the Chapter's website and click on the EIC Awards tab.

- 4. Photographs please submit a minimum of 15 and a maximum of 25 photographs in jpg format. Please note photographs taken by a professional pho-tographer must include a photographer's release in order to be included in the submission. It is the responsibility of the submitter to obtain the release. Once the nomination form is received by the RMACI office an email will be sent to the project submitter with instructions about how to upload the pictures to a Drop Box account. Pictures of the project throughout the entire construction process are preferred and should include a photo of the completed project. If ovaliable you may also submit time lapsed or drone video. Please make sure that all photographs are devoid of any date stamps, company names, or company logos. Photograph should be numbered with the project name.1,
